KAVYAVAIBHAV OF SADGURUNISHKULANAND SWAMI

Mahadevprasad Joshi (New Ranip)

In our Swaminarayan Sampradaya contribution of Vairagya Murti Sadguru Nishkulanand Swami in the field of literature of our Sampradaya is very well known. There are total twenty three creations of PadyaRachanas (poetic forms) of Nishkulanand Kavya. Among them sixteen are in Gujarati language and seven are in Hindi language. 'BhaktaChintamani' scripture having total 8527 Doha-Chopai spread in 164 Prakarans (Chapters) is considered to be at the top which was created by him in Samvat 1887 in Gadhpur. He has also created as many as 3000 Kirtans. KavyaVaibhav of SadguruNishkulanand Swami is very rich and unique in Sampradaya. One can seen AkhandAnuraag (unflinching affection) towards BhagwanSwaminarayan in his Kavyas-Kirtans.

Detailed information about other twenty two KavyaRachanas are as mentioned here.

(1) Yamdand : this creation in gujarati language was created in poetic form in Samvat 1860. In it 20 Kadva, 1 Dhol and 1144 Charan are included. This is the first poetic creation of Swami. There are descriptions about Yampuri, NarakYatana (sufferings of the hell)


(2) PurushottamPrakash : This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language. There are 55 Prakar (Prakaran) in it. There are 20 Charan in each of them. In it importance of ShreejiMaharaj has been described.

(3) SnehGita : This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 44 Kadva and 11 Padas and total 490 Charan. In this creation, one gets an understanding as to how the devotees should cherish ardent affection in BhagwanSwaminarayan.

(4) VachanVidhi : This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 52Kadva and 13 Padas and total 416Charan. In this creation, one gets to know which Vachan of Bhagwan should be followed.

(5) Sarsiddhi :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 48Kadva and 12 Padas and total 490 Charan. In this creation, one gets to know about obtaining Bhagwan as the best essence and about Samagam of real saint.

(6) Bhaktanidhi :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 44 Kadva and 11 Padas, 02 Sortha, 02 Dohas and 01 Dhol and total 508Charan. This is the last creation of SadguruNishkulanand Swami which has been created on the pious day of Chaitra Sud-09 (HariJayanti) in Samvat 1902. In this creation, beautiful description regarding

Bhakti of Shreeji and importance of Bhakti is narrated.

(7) HaribalGita :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 44 Kadva and 11 Padas and total 400 Charan. This is Balvan Gita of Shree Hari Himself. Means of Mokas like Bhakti etc. are included in it.

(8) HridayPrakash :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language in which 15 incidents have been described. In this creation, need for HridayShuddhi (purification of heart) and means to purify the heart (Devoid of Doshas) have been explained.

(9) Dhirajakhyan :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 64 Kadva and 16 Padas and total 717 Charan. In this creation, it has been described how the great devotees like Dhruv, Prahlad, Raja Harischandra, Nalraja, Raja Rantidev, Vibhishan..... etc. have tolerated innumerable miseries.

(10) Harismriti : There are 07 Chintamani in this poetic creation in Gujarati language, and there are 351 Panktis in it. It has been explained well as to how to perform Smruti of ShreejiMaharaj, MurtiVarnan, Gunavarnan and LeelaCharitraVarnan.

(11) ChosathPadi :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has total 64 Padas consisted of eight Vibhags each having 08 Padas. Here there is description of importance of Shree Hari and saints, Vairagya, AtmaGyan etc.

(12) Manganjan :This is a poetic creation in Hindi language which has 187 dohas. Here the human body has embodied as Nagar, Jeev as Raja and Mind as two Pradhans (ministers). This can be considered as RupakKavya.

(13) Gungrahak :This is a poetic creation in Hindi language which has 101 Dohas. Bhagwan is pleased by Gunas and is unhappy by Avagunas. Thus, in these poetic creations, the importance of Gunas has been explained.

(14) HariVicharan :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 08 Vishram (Prakaran) which described different Leelas of BhagwanSwaminarayan performed at different places, villages,

cities etc. places during the life-span from Pragatya till Antardhan.

(15) AarjiVinay :This is a poetic creation in Hindi language which has total 102 Chhanda and Dohas in it. It has been stated in it to make a request to Bhagwan ardently and with utmost humility.

(16) KalyanNirnay :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 18 Nirnay (Prakaran) wherein AtyantikKalyan is real Kalyan. Its swaroop and means to obtain it have been described.

(17) AvtarChintamani :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 31 Chopais in which different incarnations of Bhagwan with their Karya have been described.

(18) ChihanChintamani: This is a poetic creation in Hindi language which has 16 Dohas. In this Kavya it has been asked to perform Chintan of sixteen Chihan of Charankamal which are suggestive of Bhagwan.


(19) PushpChintamani :This is a poetic creation in Hindi language which described 31 types of Pushpas which can be offered to Bhagwan when Bhagwan graces our house.

(20) LagnaShakunavali: This is a poetic creation in Hindi language which has 17 Dohas. Description of twelve Rashis (Lagna) with its good and bad Fal has been given in it.

(21) ShikshapatriBhashya :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 260 Chopais. Detailed analysis of 212 Shlokas of ShikshaPatri with simple explanation has been given in it.

(22) VruttiVivah :This is a poetic creation in Gujarati language which has 20 Padas. Here interesting description about SansarikVivah as Rupak from the point of view of spiritual knowledge has been given in it. Reference has been made about getting Streein the form of His own Manovritti with Bhagwan.

In this way SadguruNishkulnand has described emancipation related subjects through these twenty three poetic creations which are very simple and very common. The greatness and grandeur and ParamAishwarya of ShreejiMaharaj can be noticed in his literature. Jay Swaminarayan.

This Pada of Garabi created by Sadguru Muktanand Swami is being sung by all of us regularly and yet we cannot perform Daan of land as it is desired by Shree Hari. And yet there have been a few brave and great devotees who have not only rendered services of money but they also have offered the land to Shree Hari and have achieved undying fame. Really great are such devotees! With a view that, we all may get the strength to offer Bhoomi Daan, an humble attempt has been made to write this with the inspiration of devotee Shri Jagdishbhai C. Patel (village Ola, at present Gandhinagar).

First of all by identifying Lohb the strongest inner enemy which comes as an obstacle in offering Daan, Shree Hari has said that Kaam, Krodh and Lohb all three are considered to be the three inner enemies capable of destroying us. Then also Lohb is considered to be so strong that it cannot be overcome or defeated. Lohb (greed) is considered to be Bhavan (house) of Paap (sin). There are many other Doshas which rest and flourish upon Lohb and they lead one to the hell. Lack of Daan emanates from

Lohb (greed) only. A person who is capable and yet surrenders to Lohb is like excretion. If the wealth is not used for noble purpose, it would be used in wrong direction for bad purposes. The real owner of this Anant Koti Brahmaṇd, the whole Pruthvi (earth) and Bhoomi is Bhagwan only. If Bhagwan has blessed us with the land much more than required, then it is better to offer this excess land to Bhagwan in Daan

so that we get name and fame and place in Dham of Bhagwan. If all the lands are given to the children as heir and successor then one unworthy child can sell it off like anything, in stead it is better that, we offer whatever land we can in Daan.

Everything is of Shree Hari and so what can we give to Shree Hari? If one thinks that he is giving something, he is ungrateful. Shree Hari does not want anything. It is the real way for a Satsangi to keep and offer everything for Satsang. Our hand is honoured and decorated with offering Daan only. It is better to offer immediately once Sankalp of Daan is performed. The king Siddhraj Jaysinh did so many noble things and took birth in Satsang as Bhragujit Hada Garasiya and remained in Hajur sewa of Shree Hari and rendered much devout services in Muli temple and at last got a place in Akshardham.

in the form of Batuk, Vamanji Bhagwan asked for land worth three steps from Baliraja. Shukracharya Guru of Baliraja warned him that this is Vishnu and will take away everything in three steps. Though Baliraja was born in Danavkul he did not budge from his Vachan and abandoned his Guru also and thought that the best person to offer Daan is Vishnu and offered everything in three steps of Vamanji. But in turn, controlled Bhagwan and obtained the blessings from

Bhagwan that in Patal-lok Bhagwan would remain at his gate and would grant him Darshan forever. For Ahmedabad temple two British Officers (Dunlop and Sir Andrews) obtained permission from England and offered Bhoomi Daan to Shree Hari by executing the documents of the land on permanent basis for temple. Though he himself was Christian by faith and yet being very much impressed and influenced by our Sampradaya, he offered the land to Shree Hari and first ever temple of Sampradaya in the world was constructed in Kalupur, Ahmedabad. In Muli Shree Hari told devotee Ramabhai Raja that in this world three daan are considered to be the best (1) cow (2) Prithvi (land) and (3) Saraswati-Vidya (knowledge). In Mangrol we had our temple and here temple of Shree Krishna Prabhu is to be made because this is an old place of Krishna Prabhu. Ramabhai Raja became happy and told Maharaj, "Hey Maharaj! I shall offer as much land as is required. Today is the pious day of Uttrayan and this is the best time and I have received the best person to offer Daan." It is very difficult to Chitt, Vitta, and Patra and so it is very difficult to perform Sankalp of Daan Punya. So Hey Maharaj! Sankalp of Bhoomi-Daan on this Alark Wav is performed and I shall execute the documents. Shreeji Maharaj asked to bring water and asked him to perform Sankalp. Similarly, for construction temple at Bhuj, Vadtal, Jetalpur, Dholera, Dholka, Junagadh and Gadhdha, devotees such as Gangaram, Sundarjibhai, Narayan Gar, Jobanpagi, Patidaro, Gangama, Poojaji Raja, Reva Shankar, Mahashankar, Mulji, Dadabhai, hematsinh Raja and Dada Khachar etc. ardent devotees performed Prarthna to Shree Hari and offered land and other precious ornaments. In Chhapaiya our temple is situated in residence premises of Dharmdev only.

The names of all these devotees are written so that those who are wealthy and have excess land, they can get inspiration from these devotees. Dada Khachar had offered everything to Shree Hari. Laxmiwadi name is from Jivuba who is considered to be incarnation of goddess Laxmi. Radhavav,

Bhaktibaug etc. many lands have been offered to Shree Hari. The brother-in-law of Badshah (king) offered Brahma Mahol of Jetalpur by receiving only one rupee. **Vadi of Jetalpur was offered to Shree Hari by the local Patidars and at that time Shree Hari had said, "First we were made owners of lands."**

After the construction of these historic temples, other thousands of temples of original Sampradaya have been made with the offering of Daan by the donors. Many temples have farms, orchards, gardens, gaushala and Dharmshala by which services for Thaal, garlands and milk etc. to Thakorji is being rendered and services for residence and Prasad for the pilgrim saints -bhaktas are being rendered. We also continue these services so that those who are in need may not remain devoid of anything required by the human beings. Rendering of services of Murti invoked by Shree Hari in temples is essential for Shuddhi of Upasana and for Pusti of Chaturvidh Purusharth as per Gudh Sankalp of Shree Hari. With a view to strengthen the roots of Sampradaya, Shree Hari had performed Sankalp to construct temples in different countries. And therefore only Shree Hari Himself has invoked Murti of Swa-swaroops by getting constructed nine maha-mandirs.

Detailed description of Uttam Pavitra Desh and Uttam Kaal and Satpatra has been made in Satsangi Jeevan First Prakaran A-10 and if we offer Daan accordingly then we may get innumerable times punya. But we should cherish only one aim that whatever we do, Shree Hari should remain happy with it and so Bhoomi-Daan etc. should be made in such a way that, we receive final receipt and acknowledgement of Shree Nar Narayandev invoked by Shree Hari. One should not offer Daan for personal name and fame or due to any fear or greed. Rather one should offer Daan for Dharma through Bhakti in the form of Sneh towards Shree Hari. **Bhoomi should be handed over with documents to Dharmvanshi Acharya of one's own Desh because our Ishtadev Shree Hari has executed Desh Vibhag Lekh and has made distribution of temples and the**

same have been handed over to Acharya of the both Desh. Dharmvanshi Acharya of Gadi is the representative of that Dev. So knowing it the wish of Dev, the land shall be used, the way it is desired. **Bhoomi Daan should not be made to any Tyagi of Sampradaya or to any Vimukhpanthi because it is against the Constitution of Sampradaya.** Brahmins are very much loved by Bhagwan, more than His body, other deities and even goddesss Laxmiji. Dharmvanshi Acharya is Sadachari Brahmin and is on the seat of Guru of all Tyagi-Grihi. He is the great devotee of Bhagwan and has blood relation with Shree Hari and is Other Form of Shree Hari. And so in the important decisions like Bhoomi-Daan, action should be taken keeping Him together. If one does Bhoomi-Daan to any Vimukhpanthi, it would increase in the organizations of Vimukh Parampara, by which lacs of people may get away from Bhagwan and would start worship of individuals and so one should think about the sins generated from it. And therefore Devanand Swami has stated in Kirtan **વિવેકી નારને, એમ વિયારીને જોવું, કૃપાતરને દાન દેવું તે, વીજ ખારમાં બોવું રે..... વિવેકી**

If we are not capable of offering Bhoomi-Daan then with the directions of H.H. Shri Achrya Maharaj we can offer the amount equivalent to price per Sq. Ft. determined at the time of construction of the temple at that time and thereby we can render our share of contribution. For kalian of human beings it is Tapa in Satyuga, Yagna in Tretayuga, poojan of Bhagwan in Dwaparyuga and Daan in Kaliyug for the interest of human beings. The people who follow Sadachar through Daan, Tapa and Satya they are believed to have achieved Swarga (heaven). In Satsangi Jeevan First Prakaran, A-11, it has been stated that **in this Lok Bhoomi Daan is said to be Maha Daan.** A man fulfills all his desires and wishes through Bhoomi Daan. The human being who offers to Sadachari Brahmins Pruthvi equivalent to Gocharma full of ripe Dhanya, he gets its results beyond its measurements. Gocharma Bhoomi means a piece of land on which one bull and hundred cows can sit on it. **A person who offers land is immediately absolved of all sins and immediately gets Punya**

more than Ashwamegh Yagna. A very intelligent person offers Pruthvi as also clothes, jewellery, and gold ornaments and gets result of all of them. A person who offers Bhoomi in Daan in this age ensures emancipation of his five immediate forefathers, himself and five of his next generation thus eleven Purush. A person who offers Bhoomi Daan addressing it to Bhagwan or performs Bhakti through Putkarma, he gets Fala of Antarhit.

When we offer Bhoomi Shree Narnarayandev or Shree Laxminarayandev as per Desh Vibhag Lekh, that land is already of Bhagwan and land is considered to be immovable property it is not going to be destroyed till Anant Kaal and therefore the donor of Bhoomi keeps on getting its Punya till Anant Kaal. When Daan offered to proper and eligible Vipras yields its thousand times Punya, who can describe the result of Bhoomi Daan offered to Bhagwan Himself! And so rich Grihasthi should always remain ready for Bhoomi Daan. Moreover, the land should also have been acquired through Nyay and Niti. If the land acquired through any unfair means, is donated it yields its result of equal nature and this will not do any progress of the donor of the land.



If a little bit of Daan offered to an appropriate person would yield its multiplied result. By doing so the donor becomes richer. He performs Punya again through his acquired wealth and becomes wealthier. If the donor is not Satsangi he gets Devlok and if he is Satsangi, he gets place of Bhagwan. And nobody is greater eligible than Bhagwan and so it is the best if we offer Bhoomi Daan to Bhagwan without giving any thought searching for appropriate donor.

Harimandir of this place is facing the East direction. This place has been graced by Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan a number of times accompanied by His Muni Mandal and Parshads and has sanctified it. While performing Vicharan in Dandhvyad Desh Shree Hari has graced Nardipur coming from Paliyad village. When came to know about arrival of Shree Hari, Nachiket Brahmin came to perform poojan of Shree Hari and performed poojan with Akshat, Chandan etc. and then Shree Hari graced his house. From there Shree Hari graced the house of devotees Gulabchand and Sukhchand. In such a village having great impact and influence, Shree Hari has stayed for five days and has offered Dakshina to thousands of devotees and have made them all happy. From there Shreeji Maharaj has graced village Langhanaj.

Firmness of NitaramBhakta of

Nardipur : - There was one Brahmin namely Titaram residing in village Nardipur who was an ardent devotee of Shree Hari. Titaram told them that he would forgive them all and asked them to take their seat in the divine vehicle, if they wished. The

only a lamp is required and not forest-fire to dispel darkness from the house. The forest-fire may burn everything in the house. In third Vachanamrit of Vadtal it has narrated that the forest-fire is found in the water of the ocean but the water cannot extinguish it. So the forest-fire which cannot be extinguished even by the water of the ocean, need not be brought home; the lamp is sufficient for home. Similarly, if Bhagwan intends to grant divine happiness to ardent devotee then He has to take human birth and has to perform human Charitra then only a devotee can go closer to Him. And it is easy to remember Leela of Bhagwan. So we should decide to read or listen one Leela of Bhagwan everyday. 
